# Raising the debt ceiling

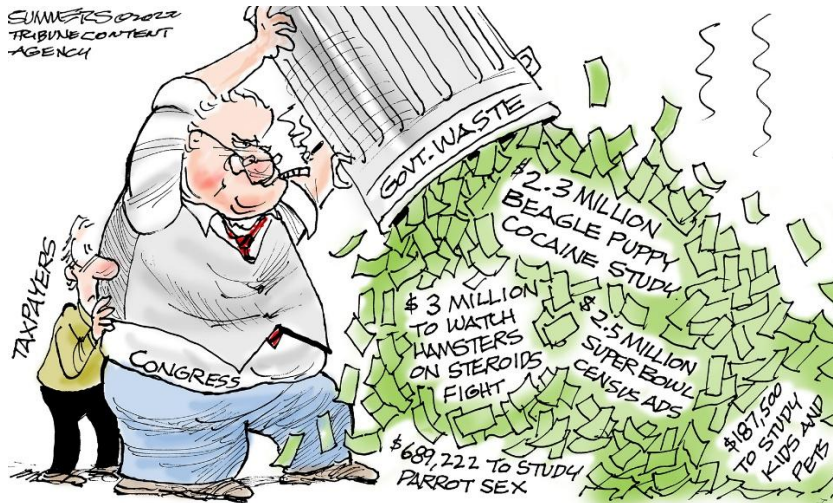
The debt ceiling – the current cause of contentious debate – has been raised 39 times since 1980. A look at under whose watch it has been raised (number of times):
