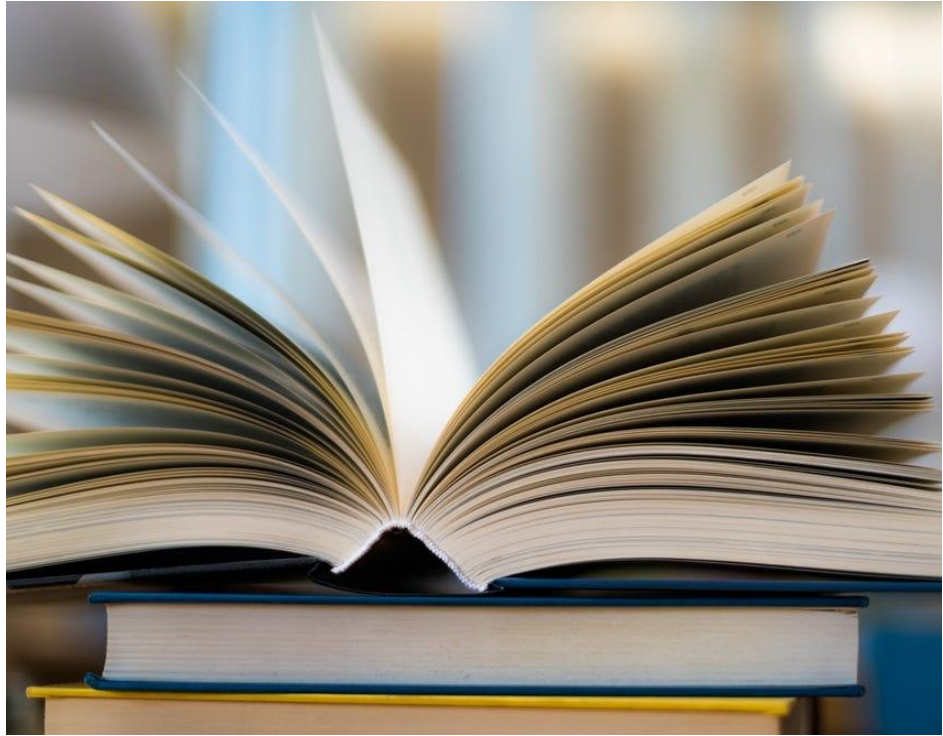
History Repeats Itself

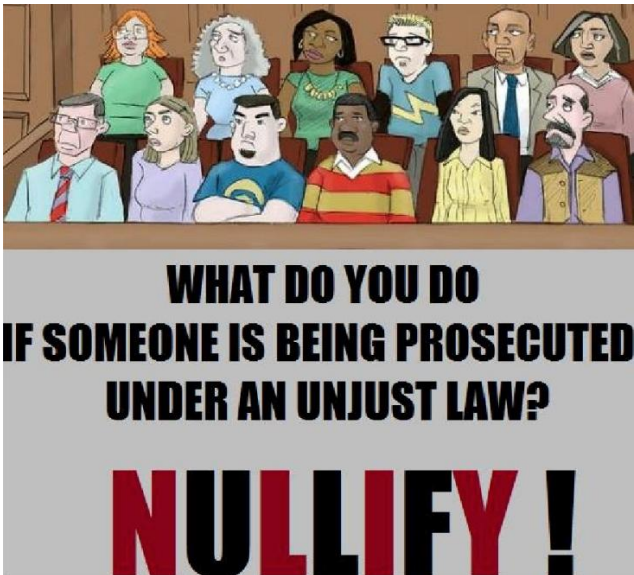

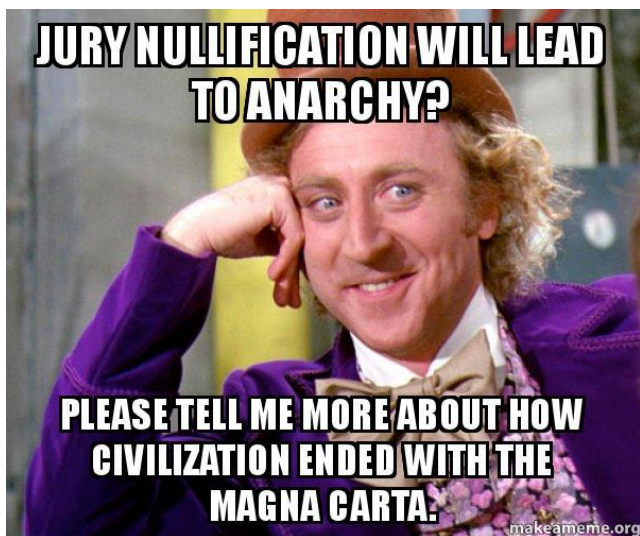

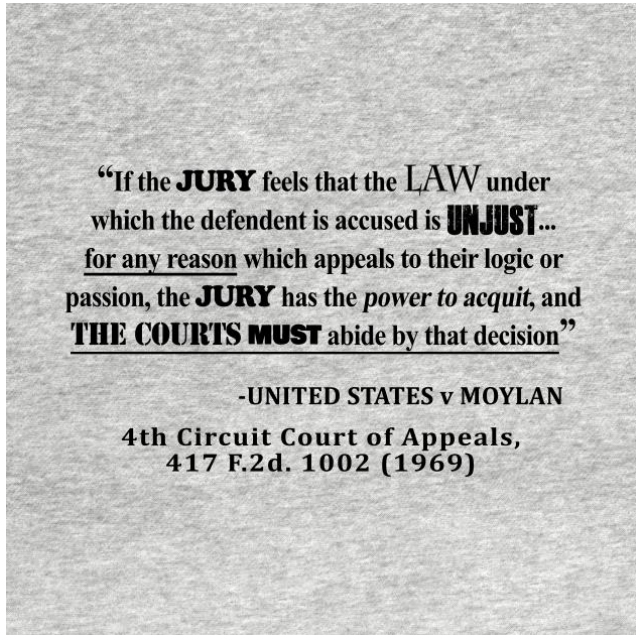
