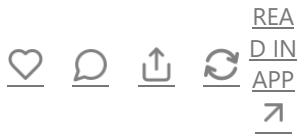
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## **Step Away from The Hyperbole**

**What is Marxism?** It is a social, economic, and political philosophy developed by Karl Marx and Friedrich Engels that critiques capitalism, arguing it creates conflict between owners and workers. It proposes that society evolves through class struggle, aiming for a classless, stateless society where workers own the means of production, ultimately leading to communism.

**What is a Democracy?** It is a system of government where supreme power is vested in the people, meaning “rule by the people.” Citizens exercise this power directly or by electing representatives to make decisions on their behalf.

That sounds better, even good, it even sounds like what we want... or does it?

### **Democracy 101!**

Democracy is known as “Mob Rule,” the majority rules and the individual or minority... loses!

Did you know that our Founding Fathers detested a democracy form of government? It's true... because it was one step from being socialist. Lenin opposed achieving socialism solely through electoral democracy, viewing parliamentary democracy under capitalism as an instrument of the bourgeoisie, but utilized the concept of “democratic revolution” as a step towards a socialist one.

**In yet another context, which I find ironic and humorous**, the once conservative critic of socialism, Irving Kristol, (aka Bill Kristol) famously argued that “democratic socialism” turns out to be an inherently “unstable compound.” Of course, he made this observation long before he was afflicted with TDS. (Trump Derangement Syndrome)

President Ronald Reagan, often cited in discussions on this topic, famously argued that freedom is fragile and that a “perversion has occurred” where rights once considered unalienable are now treated as governmental permissions, stating in 1964: *“If you don’t [write your congressman], this program, I promise you, will pass... and behind it will come other federal programs... until, one day, as **Norman Thomas** said, we will awake to find that we have socialism.”* (Norman Thomas ran for president as a Socialist Party candidate.)

It seems to me, many are counting on democracy to **“trans”** itself into socialism...communism, both of which are dictatorships! The many social programs our bureaucracy fancies, are nothing more than socialism disguised as “good deeds” and “compassion.”

**So, how did our Founding Fathers feel about “democracy?”**

**John Adams** wrote in an 1814 letter to John Taylor: ***“Remember, Democracy never lasts long. It soon wastes, exhausts, and murders itself. There never was a Democracy yet, that did not commit suicide.”*** He argued that democracies are unstable, prone to extreme passion, and inevitably violent before failing. ***“It is in vain to say that democracy***

*is less vain, less proud, less selfish, less ambitious, or less avaricious than aristocracy or monarchy.”*

Alexander Hamilton used fewer words, when he stated, **“Our real disease...is democracy.”**

If our Founding Fathers didn't like a democracy, what kind of government do we have...or did we have?

**What is a Republic?** It is a form of government where citizens hold supreme power and elect representatives to make decisions on their behalf, rather than a monarch. **It is defined by a constitution** or charter that **protects individual rights against the will of the majority.**

**What is a Constitutional Republic?** It is a form of government where citizens elect representatives to make laws, rather than voting on laws directly. These officials are bound by a written constitution—the supreme law of the land—which restricts their power and protects individual rights. It balances majority rule with minority protections.

Did you catch that? Our Constitution restricts the power of the elected and protects the rights of **We the People**, (all those inalienable rights), individual rights. Not collectivism...they do not have the power to hold your land or your property. These elected work for you... the “Consent of the Governed.”

**(Excerpt from the Declaration of Independence)**

*We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness.--That to secure these rights, Governments are instituted among Men, deriving their just powers from the consent of the governed -*

Has America already been fundamentally changed? If so, can **We the People** find our way back? Would it not be a great accomplishment if we were to actually restore our

Constitutional Republic during this historic year of our 250<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of our original Independence?

THEN, there is another question, which is vitally important; Do the People in the United States of America actually want to be a free and independent people? Or do they believe that they are free, while they are yet in the government chains of democracy?

Thomas Paine wrote in “The American Crisis,” **...tyranny, has declared that she has a right (not only to TAX) but “to BIND us in ALL CASES WHATSOEVER” and if being bound in that manner, is not slavery, then is there not such a thing as slavery upon earth...**

*Just a soft reminder we are very close to April 15 – TAX DAY... when we all must pay...or punishment will befall.*

**Bring America Home©**



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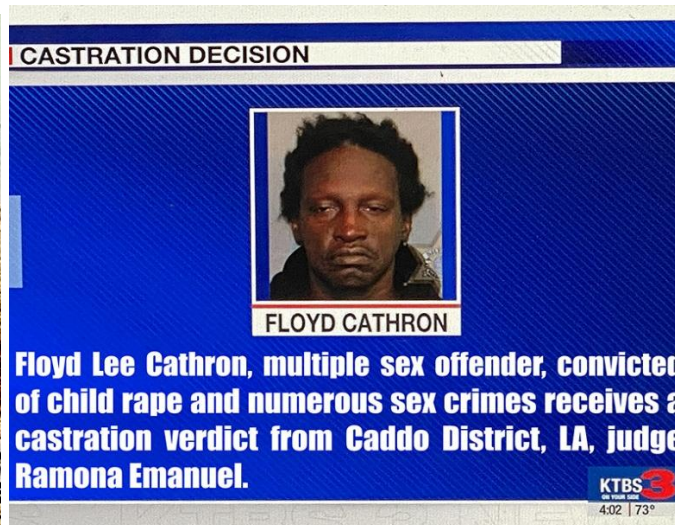
