Legislators from the state level to D.C. have placed a yoke on the American people; the problem is, we actually allowed them to do so.

According to the words of Thomas Jefferson: “The executive power in our government is not the only, perhaps not even the principal object of my solicitude. **The tyranny of the legislature is really the danger most to be feared and will continue to be so for many years to come.** The tyranny of the executive power will come in its turn, but at a more distant period.”

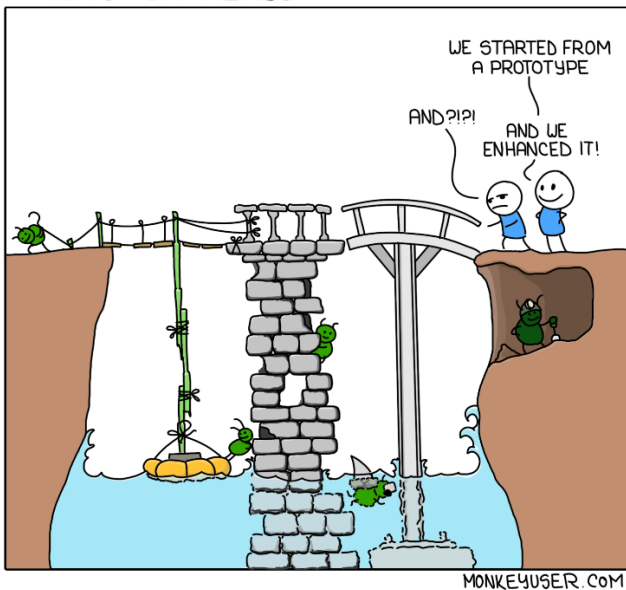
