Thomas Jefferson stated, “***Single acts of tyranny may be ascribed to the accidental opinion of the day. But a series of oppressions, begun at a distinguished period, and pursued unalterably through every change of ministers (administrations), too plainly proves a deliberate systematic plan of reducing us to slavery.***”

I believe his words in the Declaration of Independence were, “*But when a long train of abuses and usurpations, pursuing invariably the same Object evinces a design to reduce them under absolute Despotism, it is their right, it is their duty, to throw off such Government, and to provide new Guards for their future security.*”

After yet another long train of abuses and usurpations (corruption), Americans are living under tyranny again today. We watch the theater of our elected officials and the bureaucrats, time and time again debating this or that, yet the

only thing that gets done is spending more money and growing the government larger, which in turn makes Americans less free. This has gone on for decades and yes for over a century.

There's an old proverb, "Fool me once, shame on you; fool me twice, shame on me." The origin of this old, but familiar proverb isn't really known. Its origin appears to go back as far as the 1600s.
