**SAUL ALINSKY'S 8 LEVELS OF CONTROL TO CREATE A SOCIALIST NATION**

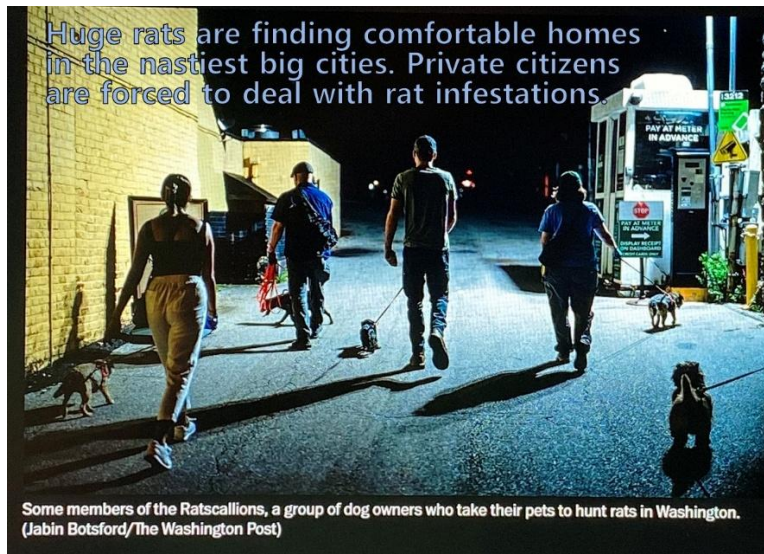
- HEALTHCARE** — CONTROL HEALTHCARE AND YOU CONTROL THE PEOPLE
