
# "Trump Is Destroying Democracy ... or So 'They' Say"

Perhaps it would serve us better if we simply discussed exactly what a democracy is, and then we can ascertain if it is being destroyed.

Let's look to the words of our Founding Fathers, who were the instruments in the construction of our government here in the United States of America. 




