The meaning of the phrase "Pursuit of Happiness" is more in depth than just simply being happy. As I began to research and study other authors on the topic there were varying degrees of opinions, and the studies went back to Greek philosophers, some of whom Thomas Jefferson enjoyed reading and studying.

Before I share the conclusion of the writing, I'll share my opinion and understanding of "The Pursuit of Happiness."

The Founding Fathers didn't want our documents to be complicated or difficult for the average American to understand. Sometimes I feel we over analyze and then miss the simple beauty of their words. Deep thinkers and studiers they were, but they were also men who simply wanted to live free of the king's continual invasion upon their lives, their travel and their properties. The king was a ruthless dictator. Our Founders believed they had a right to Life and Liberty. They believed they had a right to live their lives and pursue whatever endeavors brought to them happiness. This, in my opinion, meant individual freedom of choice. Your happiness should not, however come at the detriment of others or the destruction of life. There is a personal responsibility when making choices.

The conclusions of Locke's view of happiness includes the following elements:

- The desire for happiness is a natural law that is implanted into us by God and motivates everything we do.
- Happiness is synonymous with pleasure, Unhappiness with pain.
- We must distinguish "false pleasures" which promise immediate gratification but produce long-term pain, from "true pleasures" which are intense and long lasting.
- The pursuit of happiness is the foundation of individual liberty, since it gives us the ability to make decisions that are in our long-term best interest.
- Since there is a diversity of natures, what causes happiness completely depends on the individual and his or her own experience of pleasure and pain.
- The best bet would be to **live a life of virtue** so one can win everlasting happiness. Betting on a life of hedonistic pleasure is "irrational" given the prospect of infinite misery.
- The pursuit of happiness is also the foundation of political liberty. Since God has
 given everyone the desire to pursue happiness as a natural right, the government should not
 interfere with anyone's pursuit of happiness so long as it doesn't interfere with other's right
 to pursue happiness.

Thomas Jefferson wrote the following in a letter to William Short, as he summed up his study of "De rerum Natura" (On the Nature of Things) written by Lucretius, a Roman disciple of Epicurus:

"The moral is that happiness is the aim of life. Virtue is the foundation of happiness. Utility is the test of virtue."

"Our Constitution was made only for a moral and religious people. It is wholly inadequate to the government of any other." John Adams

Life and Liberty come with responsibilities. There are those who want total and complete freedom to do as they want without restrictions, but that my dear friends is chaos. Pursuit of Happiness also comes with personal responsibility.

"We hold these truths to be self-evident, **that all men are created equal**, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain **unalienable Rights**, that among these are **Life**, **Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness...**"

We were established as a Christian nation and we have shirked our duties as citizens and as Christians, compromising for the sake of peace which proved to be no peace at all. We must rise up and preserve what is being usurped from us. Our unalienable rights are from God not from government. What government did not give, it cannot take away, unless by our consent. (the consent of the governed)

Our Founding Fathers were thinkers. They studied philosophers and gleaned as much knowledge as they could. Their faith and their thinking did coincide and brought forth to us a nation built on ideas and principles that no other people or nation were brave enough to attempt. American Exceptionalism brought forth the American Dream.

There are men and women today who think beyond themselves as these men did. They look to the future not just for their own happiness but to set a recipe

for the growth of a nation that would enable a people **Life**, **Liberty and the Pursuit of Happiness**.

Understanding and accepting the beauty of these unalienable rights and preserving them for future generations is our right and our duty, that others might enjoy **the Pursuit of Happiness** and ...


